AGE-OUT CRISIS

Every year, 25,000 unadopted children age-out of foster care in the United States.
5,000 of those children age-out in Florida.

HOMELESSNESS

20% (5k youth) are immediately homeless on their 18th birthday.



SEX TRAFFICKING

50-90% of victims of child sex trafficking had been involved with child welfare services. (HHS, ACF, 2013)



EDUCATION

There is less than a 3% chance for children who have aged out of foster care to earn a college degree at any point in their life.

48% of homeless youth between ages 18-23 performed paid sex acts simply because they lacked a safe place to stay. (Covenant House, NYC)

OUR MISSION

We prevent youth homelessness & sex trafficking by providing free quality housing for at-risk aged-out foster youth.



OUR VISION

To provide “A Home for EveryOne” of the 25,000 children Aging out of foster care annually in the United States.

Our ability to successfully retain residents and ensure their graduation from our program is a direct result of our methodology—which we constantly fine-tune to better serve our precious foster youth.



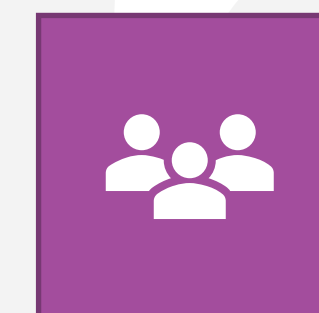
HOUSING

History Timeline

The first Legacy House opened it's doors nearly 7 years ago, our story begins even before then!



2013

Vision is Birthed

Legacy Housing Visionary, Nina Tidwell, discovered the connection between adult homelessness and aged-out foster youth.

2015

Ormond Church is Planted

Rich and Brandi plant Ormond Church with the mission of planting a home for aged-out foster youth.

2016

First Legacy House Opens

In March of 2016, Legacy Housing opens its doors to their first resident, Zoe Wiley.



2018

First Home Purchased

Giving Firstfruits Foundation purchases first Legacy House in Ormond Beach, significantly reducing overhead.

2019

Legacy Housing Network Launched

Legacy Housing begins partnership with Our Daughters House (TX) and other organizations (FL, MO, TX) to open more homes and increase impact.

2020

Legacy Ranch Purchased

15 undeveloped acres purchased in Ormond Beach in order to open first Legacy House for boys.
